This position supervises the day-to-day operations of our gallery shop, online store, and artist editions programme, which together generate vital income through Turner Contemporary Enterprises to support our artistic and educational mission.

Key tasks and responsibilities:

Shop Oversight & Customer Experience

- Supervise all aspects of daily retail operations, creating an inviting, well-merchandised environment that reflects our artistic mission and new brand identity
- Ensure the provision of exceptional customer service and product knowledge to visitors, actively engaging them with our carefully curated selection
- Train and supervise our front of house team, ensuring they
 have required knowledge of retail systems and SOPS and
 deliver consistent service excellence and product knowledge
- Serve as a key point of welcome for gallery visitors, providing informed guidance about exhibitions, events, and facilities.
- Handle challenging situations with professionalism and maintain calm under pressure.
